## **Biography – Christopher Patriquin**

Dr. Patriquin is an Assistant Professor of Medicine and Clinician Investigator at the University of Toronto. Following his hematology fellowship and subsequent clinical scholarship in complement-mediated diseases at McMaster University, he completed an honorary clinical research fellowship with the NHS National PNH Service in the United Kingdom. His primary clinical focus is complement-mediated diseases, including PNH and thrombotic microangiopathies. His Masters in health research methodology focused on effective trial and observational methods in the study of rare diseases. He is Chair of the Canadian PNH Network, site investigator for a number of therapeutic trials in complement-mediate diseases, serves on the executive board of the International PNH Registry, and is a medical advisor for the NORD/AAMDS Global PNH Patient Registry. In 2016, he joined the University Health Network in Toronto where he is a consultant in hematology and apheresis medicine.
