

Dr. Mary-Elizabeth Percival is a hematologist with a focus on acute myeloid leukemia (AML). She is an Associate Professor at the University of Washington and at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center in Seattle, WA. Dr. Percival earned her AB magna cum laude from Harvard University and her medical degree from Stanford University School of Medicine. She completed internship and residency in internal medicine at University of California, San Francisco, followed by fellowship in hematology/oncology at Stanford. She also received a master's degree in epidemiology and clinical research from Stanford. She is the principal investigator on multiple clinical trials for AML.
